

Lessons at the Foot
of the Cross
Luke 19:28-32
John 19:25

After Jesus said this, he went on toward Jerusalem. As Jesus came near Bethphage and Bethany, towns near the hill called the Mount of Olives, he sent out two of his followers. He said, "Go to the town you can see there. When you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here to me. If anyone asks you why you are untying it, say that the Master needs it." The two followers went into town and found the colt just as Jesus had told them. *(Luke 19:28-32, NCV)*

Standing near his cross were Jesus' mother, his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. *(John 19:25, NCV)*

4 Lessons from 4 Women at the cross:

1. Mary, the mother of Jesus.

Lesson: If I stay close to the cross, God will _____ of me.

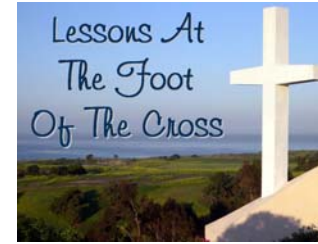
2. Salome, sister to Mary.
